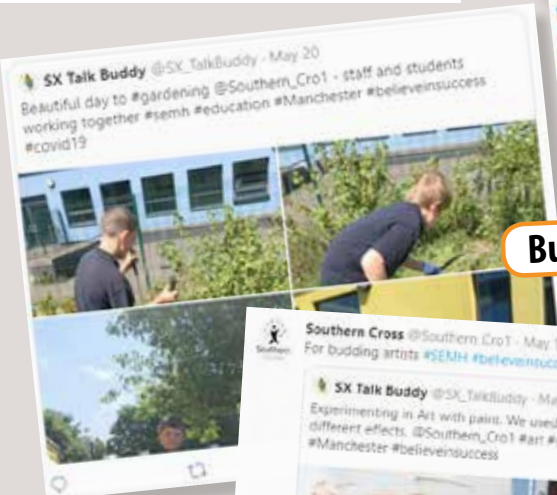


Shout out to Mr K who helped Myriad Foundation serve food to the homeless in April at Piccadilly Gardens! Well done. We are so proud of you!

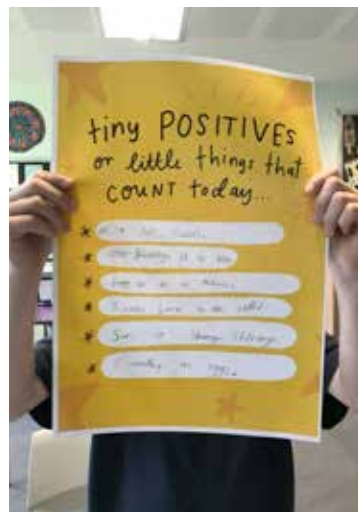
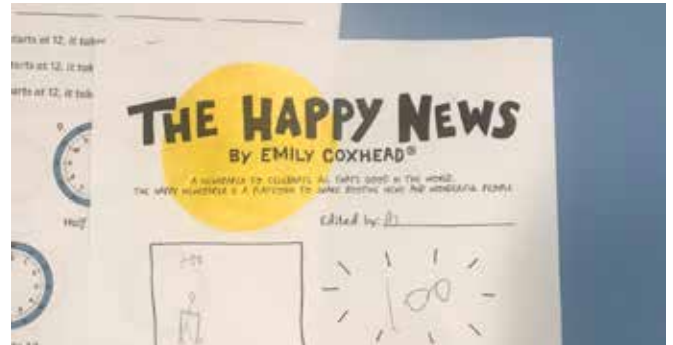




We salute Sir Tom
